Admissions Methods – How schools evaluate applicants for each program

1. **Audition** – Students must be proficient in specified area of performing arts/visual arts (see guidance counselor for audition tickets)
2. **Educational Option (Ed. Opt.)** - Open to all students of all levels.
3. **Limited Unscreened** – Must attend an open house and demonstrate interest in school
4. **Screened** – Students evaluated based on grades
5. **Specialized High School** – Exam (score on exam determines eligibility)
6. **Zoned** – Priority given to students who live in area, but all students can apply. (Exception: Midwood zoned only takes students from catch-area)
7. **English Language Learners** - New to the country
