**Senior Activity Standards**

The criteria to be able to attend/participate in any **SENIOR ACTIVITIES** are as follows:

- You **MUST** be **GRADUATING** to be able to attend a **SENIOR ACTIVITY**. “Graduating” means that you did **not fail** any major subjects for the year. Going to Summer School **DOES NOT** mean that you are graduating. So if you fail **ANY CLASS**, you will **NOT BE PERMITTED** to participate in **SENIOR ACTIVITIES**.
- The Principal, **any** Assistant Principal, **any** Dean, or **any** teacher from **any** House can **remove you** from any/all Senior Activities. This relates to behavior, attitude, trustworthiness, respect, and so on.
- You need to have an **acceptable** record of attendance for the entire year to participate in **SENIOR ACTIVITIES**. Your record of attendance refers to **you absences, latenesses to school and latenesses to class**. If it has been deemed that you have been absent or late too many times, you will **NOT** be able to participate in **SENIOR ACTIVITIES**.
- Your report card behavior marks need to be acceptable. You **CANNOT** attend any activities with a “U” as a conduct grade. You **CANNOT** attend any activities with more than one “N” as a conduct grade. Having only one “N” in **ANY class still** could make you **INELIGIBLE** for **SENIOR ACTIVITIES**.

Now you know what is expected from you. Now you know what you need to do to be eligible to participate in Senior Activities. There are **NO** exceptions to these standards.

**NOT** graduating = **NOT** fulfilling your job as a student =  
**NOT** participating in **SENIOR ACTIVITIES**

Partaking in **SENIOR ACTIVITIES** is a **PRIVILEGE** and **REWARD** for hardworking, deserving, graduating students. It is **NOT** a right.

**\*\*If you are NOT GRADUATING, there cannot/will not be any Senior Dues refunds available except for Payment #4 (\$50).\*\***

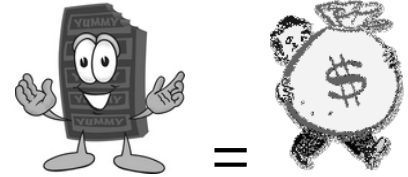

Want to raise money to pay for your Senior Dues, the Senior Trip, the Senior Prom, or ALL THREE?

**SELL CHOCOLATE !**



Return this permission slip to **Mr. Singh in room 138** if you're interested in selling chocolate to raise money for your **Senior Dues** (\$200). The 8<sup>th</sup> grade candy sale works like this...

For each box of chocolate you sell, you earn **\$30**. Mr. Singh will hold all of your earnings in a school account and will apply it to your Senior Dues balance. You will receive a receipt stating your balance every time you sell a box. **SAVE THESE RECEIPTS!** After your Senior Dues have been paid, if you want to continue, you can sell chocolate to pay for your Senior Trip and/or Senior Prom, if you're eligible to attend. The rules for selling chocolate are as follows:

- ✓ **No chocolate is allowed to be sold in school.** According to N.Y. State law, fundraising boxes cannot be sold inside of the school building. Selling outside of the school (for example – at the bus stop) is allowed and recommended. If any student is seen selling chocolate inside of the school building they will have their box **taken away** and they **will not** be permitted to continue to sell candy as a fundraiser. **No excuses. No exceptions. No second chances.**
- ✓ For safety reasons, you should **not** sell door-to-door. The best places to sell are **(1)** at the bus stop after school, **(2)** outside of a neighborhood temple/church, or **(3)** outside of a busy - *but safe* - bank/ATM.
- ✓ You **MUST** return the money to Mr. Singh within **30 days** from when you received the box.
- ✓ In order to start selling, you need to have this permission slip **COMPLETELY** filled out and returned to **Mr. Singh**. The sooner you start selling, the more money you can raise for yourself.
